

6150-14 Top-man for High Risk Confined Spaces

Course overview

The 6150-14 module is designed as a top-man or task manager qualification for persons running high risk confined space entries. This course enables candidates to competently construct Risk Assessments and Safe Systems of Work.

Who should attend?

This qualification is aimed at supervisors and task managers who will be assessing high risk confined space entries and managing work in these environments. Also forms a useful qualification for Project and Site Managers who require a better understanding of the factors involved in confined spec working.

- Overview of Compressed Air Breathing Apparatus
- Overview of Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA), looking at component parts and correct usage and maintenance
- Cylinder theory, including duration calculations
- Entry Control for Breathing Apparatus work
- Creating Risk Assessments in line with the UK Water Classifications for confined space
- Formulation of Safe Systems of Work in conjunction with Risk Assessments
- How to manage and emergency including post incident and RIDDOR reporting
