

BA02 Airline Breathing Apparatus

Course duration: 1/2 day

Course overview

The 1 day Airline Breathing Apparatus Course covers all the necessary training for users to be competent Breathing Apparatus wearers. This course can also cover SCBA usage if requested.

Who should attend?

This qualification is suitable for operatives and supervisors alike who will be required to work in environments where the hazards dictate that Breathing Apparatus must be worn. This also forms an essential step for any candidates wishing to move on to a confined space, rescue or spill response qualification.

Course Content

The course gives candidates knowledge and competence in the following areas:

- Overview of Compressed Air Breathing Apparatus
- Theory of Airline Breathing Apparatus (SCBA), looking at component parts and correct usage and maintenance
- Cylinder theory, including duration calculations
- Airline BA pre-use checks, including donning and doffing procedures
- Basic Entry Control for Breathing Apparatus work
- Practical use of Working Breathing Apparatus in a High Risk environment
