



## Mobile Confined Space Training Unit

The Mobile Breathing Apparatus and Confined Space Training Unit is a vehicle mounted facility for providing a dedicated environment for on-site training. Unlike training with existing confined spaces on-site, this facility provides a fully approved and risk assessed training environment. This means the client need only provide a suitable classroom for the theory parts of the training.

The unit allows a variety of scenarios to be re-created. Simple vertical entries and traverses, to special applications for complicated rescue scenarios can be realistically replicated. The tunnels labyrinth incorporates a number of tunnels and hatches that can be used to modify the tunnels, so that candidates on courses running over several days encounter a different scenario each day.

The unit provides a controlled environment in which training can be conducted without compromising the realism of typical confined working environments.

The unit is also equipped with infra-red cameras to allow real-time monitoring of the trainees, and for use as post training de-brief aid.
