

# CS04 Advanced Technical Rescue from Confined Spaces

**Course duration:** 3 days

## Course overview

Incorporating the CS02 course as the first two days, this course gives the candidates the ability to work as part of a confined space rescue team. Each course is dedicated specifically to a company or team, so that the course can be customised to suit your exact requirements.

Those wishing to attend should have a first aid qualification.

## Who should attend?

## Course Content

- Rescue Team roles and responsibilities
- Safe use of Rescue stretchers and casualty splinting devices
- Safe use of basic casualty care equipment
- Safe use and maintenance of Resuscitation and Defibrillation equipment
- Safely augmenting air supply
- The application of Casualty Assessment and Basic Life Support to confined space casualties
- Practical application of Rescue techniques in vertical and horizontal extractions
